(1) Develop or procure relevant learning and teaching resources as well as reference materials for CS

(2) Organise workshops and authentic learning experience related to the traditional Chinese culture and local cultural diversity

(a) Materials related to 2-day Mainland Study Tour (F5 - 108 + 12 teachers)	\$1,079 (August 2025)	An additional teaching staff was assigned to escort the students to the Mainland Study Tour and supported other teachers when there were some incidents.

(3) Subsidise students and teachers to participate in inter-disciplinary activities related to the curriculum of CS

(a) Subsidy to One-day Study Tour in Shenzhen	\$14,040 (October and December 2024)	The visit was organized by Chinese History Department and CS Department, which allowed students to acquire essential understanding about the recent development of our country and Shenzhen as well as the traditional Chinese culture. In addition, students' sense of national identity has been enhanced through this visit.
(b) Collaboration with Visual Arts Department	\$76,239 (August 2025)	Students were allowed to learn and appreciate the beauty of traditional Chinese art and crafts.
